TREASURER'S REPORT: John Moser reported a balance on hand of \$8,024.00. He noted that there is one more end of year awards bill to be paid. Motion made (M. Hetzell/K. Ware) to approve the Treasurer's report.

CORRESPONDENCE:

- A thank you was received from the Zion Church for the Christmas food basket that the GSPHC club donated for the church to present to a worthy family.
- Ken Ware gave a brief APHA report.
- GSPHC will receive, on or about January 31, \$6,845.00 in NJ Bred money.
- New requirements to receive NJ Bred monies will include:
Listing the way(s) GSPHC promotes the NJ horse industry.
We must have 25 NJ residents on our paid membership roll.
Our by-laws must be in file.
How GSPHC divides their NJ Bred Breeders money.

HORSE SHOW FOOD STAND: Bill Stowe will not be able to commit to our food stand until late spring 2008.

RING CREW: Cody Ware will handle this responsibility for 2008.

GLOUCESTER COUNTY FAIRGROUNDS RENTAL INFORMATION:

The following changes/charges will be effect for 2008:

- Rental fee: \$375/day (Saturday and/or Sunday).
- Rental fee: \$300/day (Monday through Friday)
- Stalls: \$30/stall.
- Stall cleaning: \$175/barn. Barns with portable stalls: \$75/barn. This is a \$5/stall increase.

- Electric hook-ups: \$25/day. This is an increase from \$20/day.
- Rest rooms: \$60.00. This is a new fee.
- Arena lights: \$75/day. Lights to be turned off by 11:00 PM.

GSPHC SHOW FEE CHANGES:

- Electric: Motion made (Meade/Munn) and passed that we charge \$50/week-end (Friday to Sunday). This is the fee Gloucester County charges GSPHC. It is an increase of \$10/week-end.
- Shavings: No shavings price will be listed on the show bill. However, it will be noted that "shavings will be available".
- Entry fees: Motion was made (K. Ware/M. Hetzell) and passed that all entry fees be raised. Also, the week-end fees will be adjusted accordingly.

BACK NUMBERS: Motion was made (Meade/Kinney) and passed for Barbara to order new back numbers from 100-999.

APPRENTICE JUDGE: Motion was made (M. Hetzell/Kensler) and passed that Pam Wuest has GSPHC's permission to Apprentice Judge at a GSPHC show.

RIBBONS: Barbara Mantini, Lloyd Jerred, Mary Kensler, and Jane Munn will sort and count the GSPHC show ribbons on January 18.

GSPHC YOUTH CLUB REPORT: Melissa Hetzell reported the following:

- No GSPHC Youth Club memberships can be paid at GSPHC shows.
- The Youth Club will hold a clinic on March 20 open to all riders.

GSPHC INFORMATIONAL BOOKLET: Melissa Hetzell offered to again see that this booklet is compiled and distributed to GSPHC members.

SUNSHINE CLUB 50/50: This was won tonight by Cyndy Hetzell.
