EQUINE ADVISORY BOARD: Dorothy Quirk has completed the Club operating procedures information and forwarded it to the EAB.

HORSE SHOW BACK NUMBERS: Barbara reported that she will order new back numbers, from 100 - 99, at 84 cents each, for a total cost of \$756.00.

APPRENTICE JUDGE: Motion was made (Mantini/Kensler) and passed that GSPHC allow Pam Wuest to Apprentice Judge at both our April and September shows.

NJ DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE: Marge Moser noted that, in Governor Corzine's proposed budget, the NJ Department of Agriculture would be eliminated. She asked that all Club members contact their representatives and express their displeasure about this decision.

NUTRENA FUND RAISER: Barbara Mantini presented a possible fund raiser for the GSPHC Youth Club. They would collect and redeem Proofs of Purchase from Nutrena feeds. This information will be turned over to the GSPHC Youth Club.

NJ MONTH OF THE HORSE OPEN HOUSE: June is the Month of the Horse in New Jersey. If anyone is interested in holding a "Barn" Open House, contact Marge.
