

New Jersey Bred Superior Achievement Award

Purpose:

The purpose of this program is to recognize New Jersey Bred Horses that have successfully participated in their respective breed's show program and have proven themselves to be a superior individual in either confirmation, performance or both. Also it is to recognize those New Jersey Bred Horses that have successfully participated in national or international competition or such other events that would denote a superior individual.

Qualifications:

1. Must be New Jersey Bred as defined by Equine Advisory Board Rules. Must be nominated by their breed group.
2. No competition, show, event or activity prior to 1980 will be recognized for this program.
3. Horses must be registered with one of the breed groups recognized by the Equine Advisory Board, but the owner need not be a member of any club or organization to qualify.
4. Award requirements for each breed group must be first accepted by the Breeders Awards Committee and reviewed annually.
5. Any New Jersey Bred Horse that does not compete within its own breed but has proven to be a superior individual on the national or international level will be recognized for this award upon approval of the Breeders Award Committee on an individual basis. New Jersey bred mares and stallions that have produced nationally recognized winners are eligible under rule#5.
6. A horse can only win this award one time for each breed to which it is registered. A winning horse may be deceased.
7. All horses being considered for this award must submit a complete resume of their total achievements **and a good quality color photograph, preferably by email.**
8. Awards to be presented at the Annual Equine Advisory Board Banquet. **The GSPHC will purchase 2 dinner tickets for the owner of each horse receiving a NJ Superior Award, unless the same horse is receiving the NJ Superior award for any other breed that year, in which case only 1 ticket will be purchased. One ticket will also be purchased for the EAB Delegate.**
9. THIS AWARD WILL BE LIMITED TO TWO AWARDS PER BREED PER YEAR.
10. All nominations must be submitted to the NJ Bred Secretary By October 1st in order for the board of directors to determine who will represent the Paint Horse at the Annual Banquet in January. (Due in the Trenton Office by November 1st.)

Criteria for New Jersey Bred American Paint Horse

Garden State Paint Horse Club recommends that any NJ Bred APHA Horse can be considered for the Superior Achievement Award by the Breeder Awards Committee if they meet any (1) of the below qualifications. In the event that more than two horses are nominated in a given year, the horses with the highest accomplishments on the ordered list below will be given highest consideration. In the event of a tie, the horse with the greatest number of the highest qualification will be given higher consideration. If a tie still exists, the horse with the second highest qualification will be given higher consideration.

1. APHA Horse who stands APHA World Champion (OPEN, AMATEUR, NOVICE, YOUTH)
2. APHA Horse who stands APHA Reserve World Champion (OPEN, AMATEUR, NOVICE, YOUTH)
3. APHA Supreme Champion (OPEN)
4. APHA Superior All-Around Horse (OPEN)
5. APHA Superior (AMATEUR, YOUTH) Championship
6. APHA Lifetime Leading Point Earner (OPEN, AMATEUR, NOVICE, YOUTH)
7. APHA Honor Roll (OPEN, AMATEUR, NOVICE, YOUTH)
8. APHA National (JR & SR OPEN) Honor Roll
9. APHA National Top Twenty (OPEN, AMATEUR, NOVICE, YOUTH)
10. APHA Zone Top Five (OPEN, AMATEUR, NOVICE, YOUTH)
11. APHA Rookie of the Year (AMATEUR, NOVICE)
12. APHA Performance Versatility Award (OPEN, AMATEUR, YOUTH)
13. APHA Champion (OPEN, AMATEUR, YOUTH)
14. APHA Superior Event Horse (OPEN, AMATEUR, NOVICE, YOUTH)

Commemorative Superior Achievement Award Qualifications:

1. For Jersey Bred horses who participated before 1980
2. One horse per breed group per year may receive this award.
3. All nominations must be submitted to the NJ Bred Secretary By October 1st in order for the board of directors to determine who will represent the Paint Horse at the Annual Banquet in January. (Due in the Trenton Office by November 1st.)
