NEW JERSEY BRED PROGRAM: Julie Bishop reported that the Club will receive \$590.00 in Jersey Bred Year End money. There are 10 horses qualified for the money.

EAB EQUESTRIAN OF THE YEAR: Nalyn Hetzell will represent GSPHC.

ELECTION BALLOTS: Sigrid Ware reported that she has mailed the ballots and they will be counted at the December meeting.

2009 AWARDS BANQUET/BRUNCH: Jane Munn reported that the price for the 2009 Banquet will be \$28.00.

GOLD STAR/CLUB OF DISTINCTION: Sigrid Ware volunteered to handle these forms.

SUNSHINE CLUB 50/50: This was won tonight by Jack Bishop.
