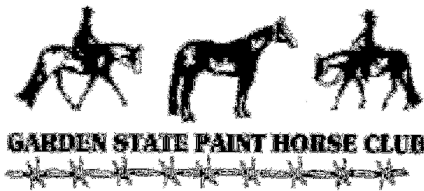

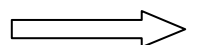

Early Arrivals - Due to GSPHC insurance restrictions, there are No Arrivals prior to the Thursday before a show weekend. Any Person requesting to arrive on Thursday must contact Barbara Mantini for club approval. **ADDITIONAL FEES FOR THURSDAY ARRIVALS ONCE APPROVED: \$65.00 for Thursday Night Stall Rental per Horse Tack. (This is in addition to the regular \$65.00 normal Stall Fee). PLUS \$50.00 Thursday Night Camper Hookup. This is in addition to the regular \$50.00 Weekend Camper Fee).**

DIRECTIONS TO DREAM PARK:

From the North:

295 South toward the Del. Memorial Bridge
Take right fork onto US-130 South toward Bridgeport/Com Barry Bridge
Go 2.1 miles
Continue on 130S
Pass under gray lift bridge and look for park entrance 1/4 mile on the right

From the South:

295 North over Del. Memorial Bridge
Continue on 295 North toward Trenton for 11 miles
Take Exit 10, Center Square Road
Turn left and go approx. 1.5 miles
Turn right on 130 North approx. 1 mile
Look for park entrance on the left at the High Hill Road intersection

From the West:

Over the Commodore Barry Bridge from PA
Take first Exit (Rt 130 South) on right
Continue approx. 1 mile south
Pass under gray lift bridge and look for park entrance ¼ mile on the right
