AWARDS

GSPHYC Day High Point and Reserve High Point awards for Walk-Trot, Youth 13 & under, Youth 14-18, Novice Youth 18 & under, Youth Solid Paint-Bred 18 & under, Novice Amateur, Amateur, and Amateur Solid Paint-Bred

Rules

- **APHA membership is required for all exhibitors to show (APHA RULE).** All exhibitors must possess a current APHA membership card the day of the show in order to show in APHA approved classes. Every exhibitor competing in Amateur, Novice Amateur, Youth or Novice Youth must possess a current Amateur, Novice Amateur, Youth or Novice Youth exhibitor card as well as a current APHA /AjPHA card (except Leadline and Youth Walk-Trot). It is the exhibitor's responsibility to ensure that he/she is eligible to enter classes. You may join on the day of the show if you are not already a member. Membership forms will be available on the day of the show for a fee as outlined by APHA.
- **All APHA rules shall be followed for this show**
- Exhibitors showing in Walk-Trot division are ineligible to ride in any other classes other than walk-trot
- Stalls: Stalls will be reserved on a first-come-first-served basis. If a reservation(s) will not be used, the stall manager must be notified at least 5 days (Monday) before the show or the person who made the reservation will be charged in full.
- **No Overnight** stabling of horses on any trailers.
- To enter grounds a current (within 12 months) proof of negative coggins and proof of rabies certificate is required on all horses.
- A two minute gate call is in effect except for tack changes. You must notify the secretary's booth if a hold is needed for a tack change at least 2 classes ahead of time.
- Entries must be canceled at least 2 classes before the class or you will be charged for the class
- Solid Paint-Bred Horses may be shown only in designated solid paint-bred classes or in NON-APHA pointed classes (Walk-Trot and Sweepstake Classes).
- Camper Rule: If using electric and/or water you will be charged a \$25.00 camper fee.
- Contestants exhibiting the same horse: "A horse may not be shown by more than one contestant in the same event or compete in the same event regardless of the Youth age divisions. (Example: A horse being exhibited in Western Pleasure 13 & Under may not be exhibited in Western Pleasure 14-18 by another exhibitor at the same horse show)." (APHA Rule)
- Returned checks: Any returned check will carry a \$35.00 penalty fee which must be paid by bank check, money order or cash.
- No awards to be given for classes with less than 3 entries.
- Sweepstake Classes must have at least 3 entries in order to be held. 80% payout based on number of entries.
- All dogs must be leashed.
- This show is being held independently from any other Garden State Paint Horse shows. Any points accrued here will not count towards any other year end awards.
- Garden State Paint Horse Youth Club or Cumberland County Fairgrounds will not be responsible for accidents, injury or loss to persons, animals or property.
