

GSPHC MEMBERSHIP MEETING
March 7, 2011

The meeting was called to order at 7:55 PM by the President, Marjorie Moser, at the home of Dorothy and Milton Quirk. MINUTES: The Secretary read a brief synopsis of the February meeting minutes. It was clarified that the Farm House Embroidery donation and drawing will be held at the July GSPHC show.

TREASURER'S REPORT: Mary Kensler reported a balance on hand of \$25,954.00. Motion was made (Gieshen/K. Ware) and passed to pay the following bills:

- Sigrid Ware: \$15.50 - for membership cards
- Barbara Mantini: \$1,572.41
 - Billing cards - \$11.28
 - Basket raffle tickets (1,000) - \$55.00
 - Postage for show approvals - \$1.73
 - Airline tickets for 4 judges - \$310.80, \$492.00, \$701.00, \$701.00

Motion was made (Munn/Kensler) and passed to invest \$10,000 of the GSPHC monies. Mary Kensler reported that she has checked on purchasing a 3 year CD and that would pay \$500.00. Debbie Kinney suggested opening an online ORANGE ING savings account. No decision was made at this time.

GSPHC YOUTH CLUB REPORT: Cyndy Hetzell reported the following:

- The Youth Clinic is scheduled for March 12. There are 25 riders signed up at this time.
- The Youth Club is making "Shoebboxes for Soldiers". They are requesting members to bring empty shoeboxes to the April membership meeting.
- They will be holding a Bedding Plant sale the end of April.
- Their Youth Club of the Year information is due APHA on May 1.
- The Club has been notified that they have been approved as an APHA "Paint for a Day" show. No date has been set for this show.

- The Youth Club members will be conducting an Easter egg hunt on the Saturday evening of the April Paint Show. Motion was made (Mantini/Kensler) and passed that GSPHC purchase the candy to be used in filling the eggs.

APHA DIRECTOR NOMINATIONS: The GSPHC paperwork has been sent to APHA.

EQUINE ADVISORY BOARD: Barbara Mantini reported that she will pick up the Jersey Bred ribbons that have been donated to GSPHC by the EAB All Breed Show.

VERSATILITY CLASSES: Co-chairpersons: Mary Kensler and Dorothy Quirk. Jane Munn will send Dorothy the rules, etc. from the 2010 Versatility Classes to review for 2011. These Non-Pro classes will be held on Saturday evening of the September GSPHC show. There will be \$1,000 added with a \$100 cash entry fee which must be paid prior to the start of the Saturday September show.

CHICKEN DINNERS - APRIL SHOW: As previously voted upon, GSPHC will be providing a complimentary boxed chicken dinner for every stall rented at the April show. Barbara Mantini will print up the tickets. Both the tickets and (after 6:00 PM) the dinners will be available from Dorothy Quirk (at the "outside" office). Additional dinners can be purchased for \$10.00 but must be ordered no later than April 17. They may be ordered when stall reservations are made or by e-mailing: quirk463@comcast.net.

GSPHC SWEATSHIRTS: Barbara Mantini will order these for sale at the April show.

GSPHC FUTURITY: The September futurity rules were reviewed. Motion was made (Cerio/Munn) to wait and see how many futurity entries we receive before we decide if we will need an additional person to be paid to handle this at the show. Motion was made (Moyer/Kinney) and passed that a futurity entry can be substituted if the original entry dies. A substitution can also be made in the same class - with the same owner - if a vet certificate is produced. There will be no futurity refunds.

SUNRISE SERVICE - APRIL SHOW: Marjorie announced that we are looking for a non-denominational pastor to conduct a short Sunrise Service on Easter Sunday morning prior to the opening of the April show on Sunday

GSPHC SCRAPBOOK AND CLUB OF DISTINCTION INFORMATION: Marjorie requested that any photos, news clippings, etc. that can be used for our GSPHC scrapbook or Club of Distinction be forwarded to Judy Moyer or Melissa Ilic.

ZONE 7 ZONE-O-RAMA - FREE STALL: Marjorie reported that the Zone 7 Committee has offered each Paint Club in Zone 7 a free stall at the 2011 Zone 7 Show. It is stipulated that this stall be used as a fund raiser for the Club in some way. Motion was made (Gieshen/K. Ware) and passed that we raffle off the stall during our April show. Raffle tickets will be 1/\$2.00 or 3/\$5.00.

GSPHC SUNSHINE FUND: Tonight's 50/50 was won by Debbie Kinney.

The meeting was adjourned at 10:00 PM with the next regular GSPHC meeting scheduled for Monday, April 4, 7:30 PM at the home of Dorothy Quirk. Judy Moyer will be providing pizza at 7:00 for those wishing to come early and eat.
