**TREASURER'S REPORT:** Mary Kensler reported a balance on hand of \$31,516. Jane Munn announced that she is going to be sending thank you letters to any sponsors or donators to GSPHC in 2011. Jane was approved to purchase a roll of stamps for this correspondence.

**GSPHC BANQUET:** Jane Munn reported that she has received 116 reservations. Judy Moyer reported that no one from APHA will be available to attend this year since the APHA Executive Committee will be meeting on the same week-end. Debbie Kinney suggested that, in the future, we consider giving free banquet tickets to some of our larger sponsors. Fundraisers to be held at the Banquet will include cookie trays, pie raffles, a general raffle table, etc. The proceeds from these raffles will not be earmarked for any specific GSPHC activity. The raffle table this year will be a Chinese Auction with cards of tickets being sold at \$15/2 cards and \$10/1 card. Motion was made (Moyer/Mantini) and passed that GSPHC purchase \$200 of gifts cards to be placed on the raffle table. Motion was made (Moyer/Nolasco) and passed that a free camper hook-up be included as one of the "game" prizes. The GSPHC Youth Club will also be collecting, at the Banquet, new pillows to be donated to a local woman's shelter and canned and packaged food items to be donated to the Pitman Food Pantry.

**APHA VARIANCE:** Jane reported that GSPHC has been approved to hold three Paint-O-Rama's in 2012.

YOUTH CLUB REPORT: Cyndy Hetzell reported the following:

- The club is collecting food items for the Pitman Food Pantry.
- They are also collecting new pillows for a local woman's shelter.

- Their APHA Youth/Amateur show will be held on July 14, 2012, at the Gloucester County Fairgrounds.
- The Club will again be participating in the Bridgeton Christmas Parade.
- Their Christmas Party will be a bowling party.
