The meeting was called to order at 7:35 PM by the President, Marjorie Moser, at the home of Dorothy Quirk. MINUTES: The Secretary read a synopsis of the minutes of the March meeting.

ZONE 7 FREE STALL CERTIFICATE: The free Zone 7 stall certificate will be raffled off at the April show. This information will be added to the GSPHC website.

TREASURER'S REPORT: Mary Kensler reported the following:

- GSPHC Account: \$24,055.00
- Fundraiser Account: \$4,000.00

Motion was made (Moyer/Cerio) and passed that our \$336.00 half page APHA ad be paid.

YOUTH CLUB REPORT: Cyndy Hetzell reported the following:

- The Youth Club will be holding an Easter Egg Hunt on Friday evening, 6:00 PM, at the Paint Show.
- Their Youth Clinic realized a profit of \$965.00.
- The Club will be holding their APHA Youth/Amateur Show on July 16 at the Cumberland County Fairgrounds. They have not yet decided if it will be a "Paint for a Day" show.
- Their flower sale is taking place at this time. Information is on the GSPHC website.
- They are filling "Shoebboxes for Soldiers".

APHA NATIONAL DIRECTIONS VOTING: Marjorie reminded the members that this voting can be done online.

JERSEY BRED PROGRAM: Julie Bishop distributed the revised Jersey Bred rules which, basically, reflect the fact that the Jersey Bred classes are being held at our September show and not at the Horse Park. Motion was made (Nolasco/K.

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Ware) and passed that these revisions be accepted and the Jersey Bred rules and information posted on the website. Julie reminded everyone that, in September, Jersey Bred horses have to show in their corresponding APHA class before they can show in their Jersey Bred class. Barbara Mantini also reported that it will be May before an announcement is made by the State in regards to Jersey Bred money for 2011.

GSPHC SWEATSHIRTS: Barbara Mantini will be ordering 48 sweatshirts in the following colors: pink, light blue, tan, olive green, tie-dyed. Pricing: Our cost - \$26/sell for \$35, \$23/\$30, \$17/\$25.

WARM UP TRAIL: There will be an assortment of trail obstacles in the warm up pen for riders to use during the show. Paid trail will be discussed at the September membership meeting.

EASTER SUNRISE SERVICE: Marjorie announced that there will be a 15 minute non-denominational service held at sunrise on Sunday of the April show.

CASINO NIGHT: Debbie Kinney reported that all of the permits have been applied for but they have not all been received. She has the Casino tickets but we will not begin selling them until all the paperwork has come through. Debbie reported that she has had several businesses offer to donate pizzas, etc. for that evening. Motion was made (Quirk/Munn) and passed that, due to the uncertainty of the paperwork for a May function, that the Casino Night be rescheduled for either October 22 or 29.

GSPHC SCRAPBOOK: Melissa Ilic reported that she is putting together a collage of photos for the scrapbook.

FUTURITIES: Glen Gieshen reported that the information is posted on the website. He will begin collecting sponsors, etc. in the near future.

SHOW REQUESTS: Lynn Fick sent the following requests to the membership:

- Check with the Dream Park and see if the fence classes can be held in the outside jump ring, where jumps are already set up. This would save the time

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of stopping to set up and take down the courses. This request has already been made to the Dream Park and we are waiting for an answer.

- Requested that we add the Green and Adult Walk Trot classes to our show schedule. Discussion ensued and it was felt that there would not be enough potential entries this year to add these classes.

SHOW VENDORS: Marjorie reported that show vendors must send a Certificate of Insurance both to the Dream Park office and also to the Dream Park's insurance company. Any vendor is welcome. Vendor fees are collected by the horse show office but are turned directly over to the Dream Park.

2012 DREAM PARK CONTRACT: Marjorie reported that the GSPHC officers met with the Dream Park Manager today to discuss our 2012 rental contract. We are anticipating an increase in rental fees of approximately \$600/day.

APRIL HORSE SHOW: Reminders:

- GSPHC will be providing a free chicken dinner to exhibitors for every stall rented. The judges will also receive a dinner. There will be an additional 10 extra ordered to sell at the show. Exhibitors may order extra dinners up to the Monday prior to the show.
- There will be a "new and improved" entry form in use. Anyone who has no changes in their show information (other than APHA cards to be checked) can turn in their paperwork at the "Outside Office". This year copies will have to be made of each Coggins to have on file for the Dream Park.

SUNSHINE CLUB 50/50: This was won tonight by Jane Munn.
