GSPHC VARIANCE FROM APHA: Marjorie Moser reported that has, "verbally" only, received information that our variance has been granted for one year.

GSPHC 40 YEAR ANNIVERSARY: GSPHC's 40 year anniversary will take place in 2013. The following Anniversary Committee was appointed: Chairperson - Barbara Mantini, Dorothy Quirk, Sigrid Ware, Mary Kensler, Melissa Buono, Judy Moyer, Marjorie Moser. It was suggested that the past GSPHC minutes be reviewed and rewritten as "Notes from the Past", possible video interviews be done with long time GSPHC members, etc. The Committee will be scheduling meetings during 2012.

GSPHC YOUTH CLUB REPORT: Gabby Buono reported the following:

- The Club's trip to Equine Affaire has been changed to the Pennsylvania Horse Expo in February.

- They will be having their annual candle fund raiser. The fund raiser returns 50% profit to the Club and will be used toward their Pennsylvania trip.
- They will again be participating in the Christmas Parade.
- Their Community Outreach Program for this year will be the Pitman Food Pantry. Club members are asked to bring their canned and/or packaged goods to the December 5 GSPHC meeting,
- The Youth Club will be putting together a basket for the Banquet raffle.

CASINO NIGHT: Debbie Kinney reported that the Club realized a successful evening with a great deal of fun had by all. The distribution of the profit, etc. will be discussed at the December club meeting. Debbie suggested that, in the future, the profits go toward a GSPHC Scholarship Fund.

JERSEY BRED PROGRAM: There were three qualified Jersey Bred horses that showed in the September show. The \$865 in State money will be distributed among those three horses.

SHOW COMMITTEE: The Show Committee meeting is scheduled for January 7.
