April 2, 2012

MINUTES: A synopsis of the March minutes was given by Dorothy Quirk, Secretary. Motion was made (K. Ware/D. Kinney) and passed that the minutes be accepted as printed.

TREASURER'S REPORT: Mary Kensler reported a balance on hand of \$27,821. Motion was made (Kensler/S. Ware) and passed to pay the following bills:

- Jane Munn: sweatshirts and T-shirts - \$928
- Horse Council Membership: \$100
- Sigrid Ware: pastage - \$19
- Barbara Mantini: airline tickets for judges - \$523 + \$253

YOUTH COMMITTEE REPORT: Debbie Kinney and Cyndy Hetzell reported the following:

- Clinic: Both the weather and the clinicians were good. There were 21 participants - most of which were non-GSPHC members. Many favorable comments were shared. Discussion was then held regarding requiring the wearing of helmets for youth participants.
- Texas Road House and/or Applebees Fund Raising Dinners: Cyndy Hetzell reported that a date for this has not been set.
- Flower Sale: Cyndy distributed order forms for anyone wishing to order flowers. They can be delivered to the April show.

CASINO NIGHT: Debbie Kinney reported the following:

- More baskets and/or donations were received than were needed for the Casino Night. The rest will be used as fund raisers at the horse shows.
- The check to the charity will be presented to a charity representative at the April horse show.
- The Club realized a profit of \$1,233.
- The suggestion was made to hold the Casino Night at one of the horse shows next year.

- Mary Kensler reported that the Fundraising Account now has \$2,653.

ANNIVERSARY COMMITTEE: Barbara Mantini reported:

- The Committee has been going through the old newsletters and minutes for interesting facts and figures to be used next year.
- Marjorie Moser reported that she has had someone offer the first GSPHC Queen's trophy, tiara, and sash for the Anniversary.

VACATION TRAVEL RAFFLE: Debbie Kinney and Barbara Mantini will check on prices to see if this would be a good fundraising venture.

TV RAFFLE: This is tabled until 2013.

GSPHC SWEATSHIRTS AND T-SHIRTS: Jane Munn reported that these have been ordered.

FUTURITY PAYOUTS: Jane Munn and Ken Ware reported that they have worked up several different payout systems that would allow more cash payouts. They suggested that we payout both Go Round Payouts as well as an Overall Average. A final decision will be made at the May 7 Futurity meeting.

OPEN/PAINT SHOW: High point awards for this show will be:

- Reserves - GSPHC T-shirts

RIBBONS: We do not need to order any more for this year,

PHOTOGRAPHER: Jane reported that our photographer for this year will be Laurie Gilmer.

APRIL GSPHC SHOW:

- All show patterns are to be sent to Barbara Mantini who will forward them to Jane Munn.
- The Amateur Halter and Youth Halter classes will count toward class counts for qualification for a DAY FEE. However, only Novice classes count toward the Novice Youth and Novice Amateur high points for the week-end.

NSBA CLASSES: Jane Munn suggested holding NSBA classes at the September show. These would be dual approved classes (meaning the APHA and the NSBA classes would run together). There is a one-time application fee to hold NSBA classes at the show. We would not be required to offer any special awards or cash payouts for the NSBA placings. Only one judge has to be used for the NSBA placings. If we charge \$6/judge - NSBA would receive \$3 and GSPHC would receive \$3.00. The NSBA horses are actually competing for their NSBA year end point money. The NSBA horses could also qualify for our 2013 World Show. Motion was made (Munn/K. Ware) and passed that NSBA classes be held at the September GSPHC show. The actual classes will be decided at the May 7 GSPHC Futurity meeting.

SUNSHINE CLUB 50/50: This was won tonight by Jane Munn.

The meeting was adjourned at 10:50 with the next regular meeting date set for September 10, 2012, at 7:30 PM at the home of Dorothy Quirk. Anyone wishing to come early to eat may do so at 7:00 PM.
