

GARDEN STATE PAINT HORSE CLUB
February 4, 2013

The meeting was called to order at 8:00 by the President, Marjorie Moser, at the home of Dorothy and Milton Quirk. In attendance were: Barbara Mantini, Mary Kensler, Margie Moser, Cyndy Hetzell, Judy Moyer, Debbie Kinney, Kaylea Kinney, Dorothy Quirk.

MINUTES: The Secretary read a synopsis of the January meeting minutes. It was noted that the Youth Club's show will be held at the Cumberland Fairgrounds and not at Gloucester's. They have picked the date of March 23 for their Clinic at the Dream Park.

TREASURER'S REPORT: Mary Kensler reported a balance on hand of \$26,563. Barbara Mantini presented a bill of \$28.61 for postage to APHA for sending in show results and mailing judges' contracts. Motion was made (D. Kinney/Hetell) and passed that the Treasurer's report be accepted.

CASINO TICKETS: These tickets can be ordered through Jane Munn when making stall reservations. They will also be available at the show for an additional fee.

SHOW STAFF - HOTEL ACCOMODATIONS: Heather Mounts has requested that GSPHC pick up part of her hotel accommodations for each show. Debbie Kinney will check with both the Comfort Inn (Carneys Point) and the Super 8 (Pennsville) for prices. Both Toby and Heather will have one room each week-end paid for by GSPHC.

40TH ANNIVERSERY: The following was discussed:

- Judy Moyer brought a copy of a 40th GSPHC Anniversary logo she had developed. This is the one we will use unless something else is decided upon.
- Motion was made (D. Kinney/Kensler) and passed that we have a budget of \$600/show to use for 40th Anniversary expenses.
- April Show: Purchase a GSPHC 40th Anniversary banner (Jane Munn will order this), 40th Anniversary towels as exhibitor hand-outs, BINGO prizes.
- July show: Gifts for guests who were GSPHC members 40 years ago, "grab bags" as random draws in 60+ classes - each bag containing "40 somethings", a "Retro" class for riders dressing as they would have if they showed 40 years ago.

- September show: awards as random drawings for "first out of the points" in various classes.
- Sweatshirts for sale at the April show - with the 40th anniversary logo.

GOLD STAR CERTIFICATES: These will be utilized as follows:

- Futurities: \$250 in APHA store certificates
- 40th Anniversary: \$250 in APHA store certificates
- Awards Banquet: \$250 Gist certificate
- Youth Leadership Certificate: we will give this to the Youth Club

SHOW COMMITTEE RECOMMENDATIONS:

Cross-over Fees: After checking to see how the \$30 cross-over fees were utilized last year (from 18 to 26 entries used it at each show), we will continue with the cross-over fees this year.

Green Classes: Since there are only 4 Green classes, this will not be a Division and fees will be the same as Open classes.

Novice Youth and Novice Amateur Year End Awards - 2013:

- Only Novice Youth classes will count for Novice Youth Year End awards.
- Only Novice Amateur classes will count for Novice Amateur Year End awards.

Apprentice Judges: Jane has been contacted asking that we allow an apprentice judge at one of our shows. Jane will be asked to suggest that she apprentice at the Youth Club's Youth/Amateur show.

Show High Point and Reserve High Point Awards:

- High Point: winners will have their choice of a \$50 Visa card or a halter
- Reserve High Point: winners will have their choice of a \$25 Visa card or a halter.
- Green classes will not count for week-end show High Points or for GSPHC Year End awards.
