MINUTES: The Secretary gave a synopsis of the September meeting and the minutes (Nolasco/Moyer) were approved as published.

TREASURER'S REPORT: Mary Kensler, Treasurer, reported a balance on hand of \$23,713 with two September show checks still outstanding, The following are the 2013 show accounts:

- April Show: Profit - \$3,058. Dream Park cost - \$14,500
- July Show Profit - \$1438. Dream Park cost - \$10,750
- September Show Profit - approximately \$631 (until all checks are deposited). Dream Park cost - \$11,488.
- Futurity - GSPHC paid out \$1,200

September office staff: Motion was made (Munn/Nolasco) and passed that Heather Mounts (computer) and Dorothy Quirk ("outside office") be paid the same amount.

Fundraising/Futurity Accounts: \$5,689. These two accounts will now be combined into one. Jane Munn recommended that these monies continue to be kept in a separate account.

BANQUET: Motion was made (Nolasco/Moyer) and passed that we provide Laurie Gardner, our photographer, with two free tickets to the banquet. Motion was made (Munn/Quirk) and passed that the Awards Committee have a maximum budget of \$5,000.

EQUINE ADVISORY BOARD REPORT: Mary Kensler reported that there will be Jersey Bred money available for 2013 and also for 2014.

SHOW SUGGESTION: It was suggested that we start the 2014 shows at 8:00 AM. This will be discussed at the Show Committee meeting in January and will be voted on at the January GSPHC meeting.

FUTURITIES: Jane reported that the tied placings received equal payouts.

EAB EQUESTRIAN OF THE YEAR EVENT: GSPHC has had no one offer to participate at this time.
