CLUB OF DISTINCTION: A letter was received from APHA informing GSPHC that the club has been designated a 2015 Club of Distinction Honorable Mention. For this achievement, GSPHC will be recognized at the 2016 APHA Convention in Richmond, Virginia.

TREASURER'S REPORT: Mary Kensler reported the following:

- GSPHC Club Account: \$26,234
- July GSPHC Show profit: \$2,856

Motion was made (K. Ware/S. Ware) and passed that the report be approved.

GSPHC YOUTH CLUB REPORT: Cyndy Hetzell reported the following:

- The Youth Show in July realized a profit of \$500.
- APHA Scholarship: The Club will be holding a raffle at the September GSPHC show to raise \$500 for an additional scholarship.
- The club is holding a candy sale.
- There will be a group of 6-8 members attending the APHA Convention in Virginia.
- She reported that the suggestion has been made for the 2016 GSPHC shows to include a High Point Rookie 4-H award. This recommendation will be acted upon at the January GSPHC meeting.

GSPHC SEPTEMBER SHOW: Due to the potential traffic congestion in Philadelphia during the Pope's visit, exhibitors will be permitted to come onto the show grounds a day early, on Thursday, and will not be charged an extra fee unless they hook-up to electric.

"CHAMPS" CLASSES: Marjorie reported that these two classes will take place during the lunch break at approximately noon. Senator Sweeney will be arriving at the show at 1:00 to make a presentation to the Therapeutic Riding Program. The GSPHC raffle permit was used for the "Smart" TV that is being raffled off by the Therapeutic Riding volunteers. The raffle money will be used to purchase a chair lift for the Therapeutic Riding Program. The lift will assist Terry in getting some of the less-able clients mounted for their lessons.
