GIST NECKLACE: The Gist necklace, that we purchased with our 2015 Regional Club money, is listed with a retail value of \$400. Raffle tickets for the necklace will be sold until the day of our December Banquet. Ana Lia Sullivan will handle the ticket sales. Motion was made (Quirk/Kensler) and passed that each of our show sponsors receive a free raffle ticket.

APHA AMATEUR COMMITTEE REPORT: Judy Moyer

Judy went over the items that will be discussed by the Amateur Committee at the next APHA Convention. She noted that the wording of the Amateur Division will be changed as follows: Age 19 - 44 will be the Amateur Division. Ages 45 and over will be Master Amateurs Division.

DREAM PARK CONTRACTS: Marjorie reported that our 2017 Dream Park contracts have been signed.

SHOW COMMITTEE: Discussion was held in regards to a horse that an exhibitor has been showing this year has passed away. The exhibitor is now leasing another horse to finish out the show season. Discussion was held in regards to possibly combining the exhibitor's points from both horses for this year. However, our show rules state - "one horse / one rider combination - no exclusions".

EQUINE ADVISORY BOARD - SUPERIOR ACHIEVEMENT AWARDS: Marjorie announced that it is time for us to submit the names of any Jersey Bred Superior Achievement horses to the Equine Advisory Board. Kenny Ware will submit one of his horses.

SHOW OFFICE SOFTWARE: Judy reminded the members that we need to purchase a newer, up-to-date show program for the Show Office to use.

SUMMER GSPHC MEETINGS: It was suggested that we consider holding a Club meeting following the April Show and the July Show. A final decision on this will be made at a future meeting.

VOTING: Voting APHA National Directors , etc. can now also be done online.

NJ QH/GSPHC PAINT SHOW: Discussion will be held at a future GSPHC meeting regarding possibly holding a combined QH/APHA show.
