

GARDEN STATE PAINT HORSE CLUB

February 6, 2017

The meeting was called to order at 7:50 by the President, Margie Moser, at the home of Dorothy Quirk. In attendance were: Mary Kensler, Margie Moser, Lorrie Scorer, Cyndy Hetzell, Judy Moyer, Barbara Mantini, Ken Ware, Sigrid Ware, Dorothy Quirk.

MINUTES: Motion was made (K. Ware/Kensler) and passed that the January minutes be approved with the following clarification: "To be considered a "Rookie", the exhibitor must not have "received points" in any Breed show."

"FRISBEE" RANDOM DRAWS: A "random draw" placing will be chosen from each class to receive a "Frisbee". The "back number" of the random draw will be written on the Frisbee and will be picked up at the "Outside Office". A "Frisbee Throw" will take place both on Saturday evening and after the last class of Sunday. This will take place at the July show. Motion was made (K. Ware/Kensler) and passed that we have our "GSPHC logo" printed on each Frisbee.

MEDALLIONS: For our September show, only first and second place winners will receive a medallion. Ribbons will be available for all other placings.

CLUB OF DISTINCTION: Marjorie reported that she has received all of our "gift certificates, etc." from APHA.

"CHAMPS" CLASSES: Again this year, "Real Women Ride" / Erica Davidson will be sponsoring all of the CHAMPS classes (\$450) at the GSPHC shows.

SHOW OFFICE: Barbara Mantini reported that she had received an e-mail from Heather Mounts stating that she will probably not be doing any horse show office work this coming year. Motion was made (K. Ware/Kensler) and passed that Barbara contact Heather and see if she would continue in the GSPHC show office if GSPHC pays for her hotel room. More on this at the March meeting.

"THANK YOU": A "thank you" card was received from Jane Munn thanking GSPHC for remembering her at her mother's funeral.

DELMARVA PHC REQUEST: A letter was received from the Delmarva Junior PHC asking if GSPHC would donate a "free stall" at one of our shows, in return for a "free stall" at the DPHC Futurity Show. Since we have already filled a request for the "free stall" we give away each year, that request was denied.

APHA CONVENTION "BREAK" SPONSOR: An e-mail was received from APHA asking if we would be interested in sponsoring one of the "breaks" during the upcoming Convention. Discussion was held and it was decided to use those monies to put toward "gifts/awards/random draws" at our GSPHC shows.

RANCH HORSE PLEASURE: It was brought to our attention by Judy Moser, that there are two sets of rules for "Ranch Horse Pleasure". Motion was made (K. Ware/Kensler) and passed that GSPHC use the "SHOT" ("Stock Horse of Texas") rules. This information will be posted on the GSPHC website,

APHA CONVENTION : Judy Moyer distributed the packet of rules that will be voted on at the upcoming Convention. Each rule was read, discussed, and then voted on for Marjorie Moser (our Delegate) to cast the APHA vote at the Convention.

Motion was made (Mantini/Quirk) and passed that GSPHC reimburse Judy Moyer for one-half of the cost of her hotel room at the Convention.

GSPHC YOUTH CLUB REPORT: Cyndy Hetzell reported that the Youth Club annual clinic is scheduled for March 19 at the Dream Park.

GSPHC "HISTORY": Dorothy Quirk reported that the "History of GSPHC" - through their meeting minutes - has been updated and posted on the GSPHC website. Highlights of those minutes were discussed and enjoyed.

TREASURER'S REPORT; Mary Kensler reported that GSPHC:

- Brought in \$94,602 in 2016
- Spent \$92,086 during 2016
- Realized a profit in 2016 of \$2,564
- Balances in our current accounts are:
 - Fundraising account - \$375
 - Scholarship account - \$866
 - GSPHC Treasury - \$24,234

The meeting was adjourned at 10:55 PM with the next regularly scheduled meeting set for 7:30 PM, Monday, March 6, 2017, at the home of Dorothy Quirk. Pizza will again be available for anyone wishing to arrive early.
