- The Club is collecting Peanut Butter for a planned "PB Challenge". The money will be donated to the Food Pantry.

APHA REQUIREMENTS: Marjorie reported that our 2020 Financial Report and 2021 Membership List is due to APHA.

EQUINE ADVISORY BOARD: We need to send both our By-laws and membership list to the Board.

SWEATSHIRT SALE: Cyndy Hetzell is ordering GSPHC sweatshirts to sell at the April Show.

2020 END OF YEAR AWARDS: Ashley reported that she will bring the awards to the April Show. There are 34 members receiving awards this year. Ashley will be handing out the awards. Barbara Mantini will develop a Program Book. The presentations will be done during / or at the end of the show on Saturday.

'OPEN' SHOWMANSHIP CLASS: This is a new class. The winner will receive a buckle. Daisy Brown will get awards for the winners for second through 10th place.

SPONSORSHIPS: Ashley reported that she has sent out 35 sponsor requests.

APHA NATIONAL CONVENTION REPORT: Judy gave a report on the National Convention results.
