

GARDEN STATE PAINT HORSE CLUB
November 7, 2005

The meeting was called to order at 7:40 PM, by the President, Marjorie Moser, at the Malaga Diner. MINUTES: The following corrections were made to the October minutes:

- Ken Ware's bill to the APHA Convention was actually \$735.55. It had been rounded to \$735.00 in the minutes.
- The APHA Maiden Halter Classes are futurity classes to be held only at the Las Vegas show.

Motion was made (J. Moser/Kensler) and passed that the October minutes be accepted with the above noted changes.

TREASURER'S REPORT: John Moser reported a balance to date of \$12,758.00. John noted that all the September show expenses have been paid and the balance includes \$1,000.00 of End of Year awards already paid.

Motion was made (K. Ware/Jack Bishop) and passed that Barbara Mantini be reimbursed \$59.85 for copies, copy paper, phone calls, postage in connection with the September horse show.

The amount of \$448.00 has been reimbursed to the club for Judge Betty Wilson's plane ticket, which had to be booked twice.

NJ BRED ALL BREED SHOW MONIES: Julie Bishop reported that there were 37 Paint horses shown at the NJ All Breed Show. This will give the Club \$11,000.00 in Jersey Bred money to distribute. The All Breed Show day money should be available the middle of December.

SHOW COMMITTEE REPORT: Jane Munn reported that she has received contracts from a majority of the 2006 judges. She will be changing the wording on the 2006 show programs from "Breeding Stock" to "Solid Paint

Bred". She also noted that the July show days will begin at 7:00 AM. We have no food vendor hired, to date.

GREEN HORSE/GREEN RIDER PROCEEDS: Motion was made (K. Ware/Kensler) and passed that the 2005 proceeds from these classes be sent to the American Horse Council Katrina Horse Rescue Fund.

WEBSITE: The Futurity results are not posted on the website at this time due to a transmission problem. This is in the process of being corrected. All the Jersey Bred information is posted.

JERSEY BRED SHOW: Barbara Mantini reported that the Equine Advisory Board is looking to change the date of the Jersey Bred Show to one week later in September.

JERSEY BRED PAYOUTS: Julie Bishop reported that the following amounts will be paid to the 37 qualified horses. There were 5 more qualified horses in 2005 than in 2004.

First: \$388.00 (down \$25.00)
Second: \$294.00 (down \$30.00)
Third: \$243.00 (down \$35.00)
Fourth: \$192.00 (down \$45.00)

EAB EQUESTRIAN OF THE YEAR: This competition will be held at the Farm Bureau Dinner this year. Allie Sharp will represent the GSPHC.

FUTURITIES: Chairperson: Debbie Kinney

GARDEN STATE BREEDERS CLASSIC (formerly the BIF): Debbie suggested the following: All monies will be paid the year the foal is born. Cost for the stallion owner to nominate his stallion - \$125.00. Nominating after February 15 to close - \$250.00. Cost for the mare owner to nominate the mare - \$60.00. Nominating from March 1 to May 1 - \$120.00. Nominating from May 1 to August 1 - \$180.00. Foals must be nominated by August 1 - \$50.00 with an additional payment due September 1 - \$60.00. There will be no "day of" entries. The stallion owner will get 10% of the

foal's winnings. Complete Garden State Breeders Classic rules will follow. Motion made (Jerred/Brandi Bleifuss) and passed that the Classic be held for weanlings, yearlings, and Longe Line entries. Note: There would only be a weanling class this year.

OPEN FUTURITY: Debbie noted that any sponsor monies raised would be added to the Open Futurity. Motion made (Kinney/K. Ware) and passed that the Open Futurity be held for weanlings, yearlings, and two year olds.

JACKPOT CLASSES: Motion was made (Meade/Brandi Bleifuss) and passed that the following Jackpot Classes be held this year: Open and Non Pro - Longe Line, Western Pleasure, Hunter Under Saddle, and Trail. An Amateur card will be required to enter the Non Pro classes.

YOUTH CLUB: Brittany Weir reported that:

- The next Youth meeting will be held prior to the December GSPHC meeting.
- They will be holding a benefit Handicapped Riders Ride in April 2006.
- An English clinic will be held in April 2006.

YEAR END AWARDS: Jane Munn reported that all the awards have been ordered. She reminded everyone to bring donations for the Chinese Auction.

APHA YEAR END AWARDS REPRESENTATIVE: Marjorie Moser will call APHA and request having an APHA rep attend the Awards Brunch.

NEWSLETTER: Motion was made (Jerred/Michalenko) and passed that all current 2005 GSPHC members receive the January 15 newsletter and the 2006 rule/informational packet. Additional newsletters will be mailed April 1, June 1, and September 1. A new membership application will be included in the January 15 newsletter.

COVER ADS: Sigrid reported that only 4 of the 2005 published newsletter cover ads were paid for. Motion was made (Mantini/Kensler) and passed that the newsletter cover ads be discontinued.

NOMINATIONS/ELECTION:

Motion was made (Jerred/Brandi Bleifuss) and passed that the following slate of officers be re-elected for 2006. There were no other nominations and none of the positions were contested.

ZONE 7 COMMITTEE MEETING: Barbara Mantini reported that the 2005 Zone 7 Show was the largest to date with 696 entries. This was partly due to the free Novice Youth cross over fee. A Silent Auction was held for the first time and will be held again in 2006. The Battle of the Barns will again be held in 2006.

SUNSHINE FUND 50/50: This was won tonight by Sigrid Ware.

The meeting was adjourned at 9:25 PM with the next regularly scheduled meeting to be held December 5 at the home of Milton and Dorothy Quirk, 463 Auburn Road, Woodstown, NJ (856-769-2540/3494). There will be a Covered Dish Dinner at 7:00 PM prior to the meeting, which will begin at 8:00 PM.
