TREASURER'S REPORT: Marjorie Moser reported a balance from the June, July, and August audits of \$12,671.00.

APHA RECOMMENDATIONS: Barbara Mantini reported that APHA is recommending that Show Committees provide scribes for judges for individually worked classes (particularly trail, reining, and western riding). Barbara recommended that we have several qualified persons able to scribe available on the showgrounds for each show to volunteer in the event scribing services are requested.

YOUTH CLUB REPORT: Ashley Nolasco reported:

- The Youth Club will be selling hot foods and snacks the Friday evening prior to the September show.
- The Club is looking for sponsors for the challenged riders program.
- Their Club Treasury to date is \$434.00.

APHA CLUB OF DISTINCTION: Marjorie Moser reported that she has been informed that GSPHC has been chosen as one of the APHA Clubs of Distinction for 2005. Ken Ware and the GSPHC Youth Club members will accept this award at the Convention. Robin Donohue will be keeping the Club of Distinction information from this point on.

BIF: Judy Moyer reported the following entries for the BIF Futurity:

- 4 fillies
- 3 colts
- 3 longe liners
- 1 two year old

There will be yearlings and two year olds in 2007, but no weanlings. Motion was made (K. Ware/Kensler) and passed that the BIF be paid out and closed in 2007.

FUTURITIES: Debbie Kinney reported that all but two futurity classes have filled. She has raised \$1,780.00 in sponsorships for the Futurity. Motion was made (K. Ware/TK Meade) and passed that GSPHC add an additional \$1,000.00 to the futurities.

JERSEY BRED SHOW: Marjorie Moser reported that she has received one valid vet certificate for the show. Julie Bishop reported that there was a horse entered in the show whose owner is not a GSPHC member. That would automatically make the horse ineligible for GSPHC Jersey Bred year end monies even though the horse did show at the Jersey Bred Show, the owner was not a Club member at that time.

APHA CONVENTION: Ken Ware noted that the HYPP question will be up for discussion at the Convention.

SEPTEMBER SHOW RING CREW: At this time, it is probable that the GSPHC Youth Club will handle these duties as a fund raiser for their Club.

GSPHC SWEEPSTAKES CLASSES: Motion was made (K. Ware/A. Meade) and passed that the payouts for the sweepstakes classes will be the same as the percentage listed on the GSPHC website as follows:

- 1-3 horses: pay 1 horse
- 4-6 horses: pay 2 horses
- 7-9 horses: pay 3 horses

The meeting was adjourned at 9:05 PM with the next regular meeting date set for October 2, 2006, at the Elmer Diner.
